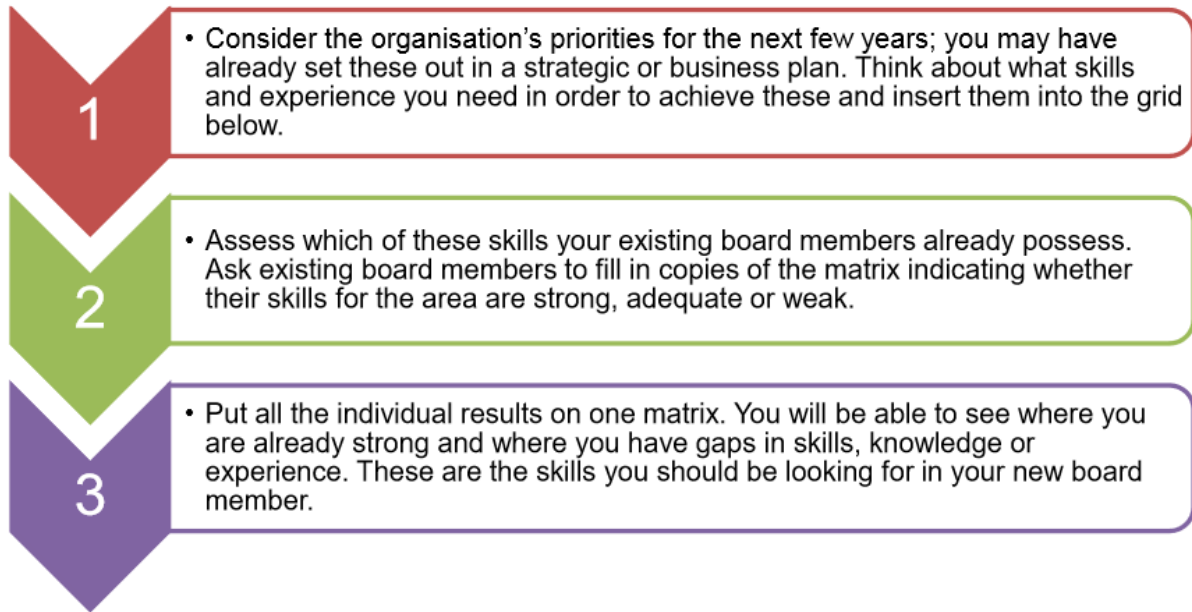


**Argyll and Bute Third Sector Interface
